

International Experts in Tinos for the Immunovirology Masterclass

The island of Tinos will host a major international scientific event: the **Masterclass in Immunovirology**, which will take place from **September 24 to 27, 2025** at the **Cultural Foundation of Tinos**.

The Masterclass is co-organized by **Democritus University of Thrace (Greece)**, **Emory University (USA)**, **The University of Western Australia**, and the **Cultural Foundation of Tinos**, reflecting a strong commitment to international collaboration and scientific outreach.

Over four days, the program will bring together **20 internationally renowned professors and researchers** along with **30 young scientists, undergraduate and postgraduate students, and PhD candidates**. Sessions will cover:

- Virus–host interactions
- Emerging viruses and pandemic preparedness
- Vaccines and antivirals
- Viral genomics and evolution
- Oncogenic viruses

Special emphasis will be placed on the contribution of the **Greek scientific diaspora**, who are a **driving force of innovation and commitment to their homeland**, focusing their research on the development of **new drugs and vaccines against viral infections**. Through a **roundtable discussion**, they will also share this expertise with the broader public.

The choice of **Tinos** as the venue is highly symbolic: the island combines **modern, high-standard infrastructure** for scientific meetings, the **active support of local authorities**, and a **unique environment** that blends the **natural beauty of the Cyclades** with the island's **spiritual and cultural character**, offering a setting that inspires both science and culture.
